Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the

Register of the Land Office at Gainesville, Florida

, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto,

the claim of Horace G. Drawdy has been established

and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South half of the North East

quarter of Section twenty-two, in Township four South, of

Range fourteen East of Tallahassee Meridian, in

Florida containing seventy-nine acres and eighty-

seven hundredths of an acre,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now, know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Horace G. Drawdy the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Horace G. Drawdy and to his heirs and assigns forever. ~~And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.~~

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

sixth.
